

Well another month has come and gone and the plaster has been flying, paint splatters everywhere and no end in sight to all the projects to be done. But I have one easy project that will dress up your playing field in no time. All you need is an SOS scrubbing pad, 2 different colored flock, and some glue.



(1), take the SOS pad and stretch it into a long log shape. (2). Take the log shape and divide it into halves, you will use only one section for your hedge row



(3). Take your half section and gently pull the strands apart and shape it to resemble a hedge row. Don't worry if it doesn't look like a hedge row, Mother nature has a lot more practice at making hedge rows.



(4) Now take your glue and water to make your 50/50 water-glue spray mixture and liberally spray the hedge, making sure to soak the entire area.



(5) Take the darker colored flock and sprinkle the flock all over the hedge,

completely covering it.



(6) Now, take your lighter colored flock and cover the base you have chosen, making sure you cover the entire base.



(7) You can add a little moss to add a little color and variation. Remember you can always experiment with different colors of flock, moss, and

different styles of any kind of base material.



Remember, All Hallows Eve is around the corner, make sure you have plenty of fluids for the masses and candy for the gobbos.
