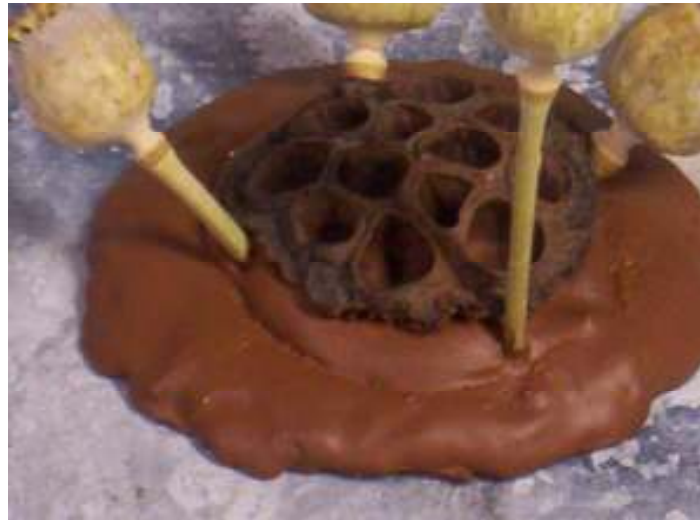
Let's make our base. Take an old CD and put tape over the hole.



Next, take your plaster mixture and cover the cd and press the pieces into the plaster. You will have to support the long stems until the plaster hardens, usually overnight.



After the plaster has dried, it is now time to paint. First, put a base coat of a dark brown.



After the first coat had dried, it is time to add a little flock effect. Take some moss, you can buy this at your local hobby store, or you can collect it from the woods off of dead trees.



Now it is time for a little detail work. Take some black paint and lightly brush the exposed brown areas



Add body parts to various areas to your new monstrous creation. Add you are done.



You never know where this creature might appear. Remember, keep your paint closed tight, and keep your plaster dry.
